

Greiner Bio-One Opens New Logistics Centre

More than 15 millions euros have been invested at the Kremsmünster headquarters. An extremely modern logistics system will ensure highly efficient processes. Furthermore the warehouse space has been almost doubled with the new building.

Kremsmünster, 1st Sept. 2011 – Today the new Greiner Bio-One Logistics centre was officially opened in Kremsmünster. "Our products are sold in more than 100 countries across the world. By optimizing workflows and increasing capacity we can ensure even faster deliveries worldwide for the future," said Axel Kühner, Chairman of the Board at Greiner Bio-One International AG, emphasising the importance of this investment, both for the company and its customers.

Constructed in record time

The new high shelves warehouse with close to 2000m² space as well as incoming goods and shipping areas of equal size was constructed in just over a year. Access and manoeuvring for lorries has been made even easier thanks to the generous parking and loading area. In addition, a large area for commissioning has been set up and there is ample room for new offices. Around 50 employees are now based in the new building. This was a necessity due to the continued increase in employees over recent years as the company has grown.

Warehouse capacity doubled

Capacity for an additional 5300 pallets has been created in the logistics centre. When added to the existing warehouse, the company now has space for 11,536 pallets at the Kremsmünster location. In future, the "old" warehouse will be used for storage of purchased parts, semi-finished goods and auxiliary materials for production.

Numerous guests

Well-known guests from politics and business were present at the opening ceremony. Besides Governor of State Dr. Josef Pühringer, Dr Paul Rubig, Member of the European Parliament and Gerhard Obernberger, Mayor of Kremsmünster were amongst the prominent guests.
